What is a support plan?



A support plan makes sure the support needs of a participant are met.



Support plans explain the way Butterfly House will meet the needs and goals of a participant.



Butterfly House staff talks about your needs with you and your support people.



All information you give us will be recorded and used to create a support plan.



All information is safe and stored securely.



Butterfly House will also do a risk assessment.



The risk assessment is then used to make a plan of support to lower the risks.



Butterfly House will check in on these risks over time.



Butterfly House will offer a disaster management plan in case of emergencies.



Butterfly House will ask to hold meetings to talk about the progress.



Butterfly House will ask if it is okay to share the plan.



Butterfly House will share this plan with people involved in your support.



If you do not want this shared with anyone we will make sure no one has access to it.
